

HEALTH REQUIREMENT FORMS 9TH GRADE & New Student ENTRY

Schedule Your Examination and Immunization Appointments TODAY!

1. PHYSICAL EXAMINATION IS DUE BY JULY 1, 2012

- Examination must be completed on or after August 21, 2011.
- Submitted on the Department of Human Services (DHS) examination form.
- Health History Portion of Form: Must be completed, signed and dated by parent/guardian.
- Approval for participation in Physical Education and IHSA Sports is indicated on the DHS exam. **IHSA Sport Physical forms are not accepted.**
- Incomplete examination forms will not be accepted and returned.
- Keep a copy for your records.

2. IMMUNIZATIONS

- All as required by the IL Department of Public Health.
- **NEW IDPH rule adopted in Sept, 2011**, mandates that all students enrolled in grades six through twelve, show proof of receiving **one dose of Tdap** (defined as tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis) vaccine regardless of the interval since the last Dtap, DT or Td dose.

3. EMERGENCY HEALTH CARD

- Must be completed and signed by parent/guardian.
- Includes permission to administer Tylenol and/or Advil at school if needed. Please check off.

4. ADMINISTRATION OF MEDICATION FORM

- Available on school website if needed: www.barrington220.org/BHS at Health Office link.
- If your child needs to take any medication at school (including prescription and over-the-counter medication) this form must be completed and signed by PARENT and PHYSICIAN.
- **Self Carry Medications Such as Asthma Inhalers, Epi-Pens and Insulin: Medication Forms must be on file with the School Nurse.**

5. DENTAL EXAM is highly recommended, but not required.

6. VISION EXAM is required for new out of state/country students: Eye examination by an optometrist or physician who provides eye examinations must be submitted to the school no later than October 15th. The examination must be completed within one year prior to the first day of the school year the child enters the Illinois school system for the first time. The parent of any child who is unable to obtain an examination must submit a waiver form to the school.

Parents/guardians who object to examination or immunization on religious grounds are not required to submit their child or ward to either, provided the parents or guardians present a signed statement to this effect. The objection must set forth the specific religious belief which conflicts with the examination or immunization(s).

**Students will not be allowed to register in August if these forms are not on file.
Per School Board Policy 7:100, students not meeting the physical examination and immunization
requirements prior to the first day of school, will not be allowed to start classes.**
